# **POLICE CHIEF'S REPORT**

James Welch reported:

- 1. Provided monthly reports.
- 2. There was a burglary on Drury and the person responsible is in jail. Wichita has several charges against him. Sedgwick County will let us know if they can include our charges.
- 3. We only received one quote for garage bids for the police department. MOTION: (S. Wagle) I move to approve Southwest Remodeling to build a 3 car garage for the police vehicles, and an area for storage, \$186,671.34. Seconded by J. Cohlmia: approved unanimously. The Police dept equipment reserve will pay \$35k and the rest will come from capital improvement. There is some clarification requested for the electrical for the garage from ESI.
- 4. Received two quotes for body and car camera One quote was from Axon for \$72,751 and Utility for \$54,430. Utility has GPS, if an officer is down everyone is notified immediately, camera footage is uploaded to the cloud, 5 year warranty, product will be available in September.

MOTION: (A. Standifer) I move to approve Utility body and vehicle cameras for \$54,430 for a 5 year payment plan of \$16,330 1<sup>st</sup> year and payments 2-5 will be \$9,525 from police budget. Seconded. R, Hostert; approved unanimously.
